



Introducing the EACUBO Member Community

EACUBO is pleased to announce a new online member service called the EACUBO Member Community. The EACUBO Member Community allows members to connect online with professional peers, initiate discussions to solve problems, and share ideas and post resources, such as best practices and model policies and procedures. The Member Community allows online groups to form around common interests to solve current problems in a collaborative environment.

The Member Community allows members to:

- Post a detailed profile so professional peers can find them for networking.
- Connect with other members to stay in touch and discuss hot topics and solve problems.
- Post messages to email groups on topics of interest.
- Join groups of like-minded members with common interests.
- Post documents, presentations, pictures, videos or other content relevant to college and university business officers.
- Find resources such as documents, best practices, model policies and procedures when you need them.

The Member Community consists of three modules:

Directory: This module provides the means for members to network with colleagues. Members can create a detailed profile that will allow them to connect with other members who have similar interests. This module is administered through the NACUBO web site and members will login using their EACUBO login and password on the NACUBO site. Please note if you have already signed up for NACUBO Connections, you will use the same login for EACUBO as you have established for the NACUBO site. Both sites use a single login.

Discussion eGroups: This module allows members to participate in discussions as part of pre-defined groups. Groups can be organized around topics or other common characteristics, such as type of institution, institutions within a state or city, etc. All discussion threads are organized and archived for easy retrieval.

Resource Library: Members can share resources online in topic-based libraries and download resources posted by other members. Members can search for documents by key words or dates.

The Member Community is integrated with the EACUBO membership database and email.
